



What is the Starlight Band?

Starlight is Oklahoma's only professional concert band. Founded in 1947, Starlight Concerts present quality, live music to Oklahoma audiences each summer. Starlight concerts are **FREE** and informal, allowing families to bring their friends (including pets), picnic baskets, and lawn chairs to the outdoor venue to listen to a variety of music, including jazz, big band, patriotic pieces, favorite tunes from Hollywood, and more. What is the Starlight Junior Board?

The Starlight Junior Board is a volunteer team made up of high school students from all over Northeast Oklahoma who are involved in music within their communities and schools. These students help with our fundraisers, prepare the weekly programs, sell concessions, set up and tear down each concert, and greet our audience members at the concerts.



What do I get out of it?

At one of the concerts **YOU** get to play with the Starlight Band! Each student will join the band to rehearse and perform underneath the stars. This opportunity allows you to not only play with a professional group but also learn how a non-profit organization works, gives you an accomplishment to list on your resume, and counts toward volunteer hours for school/clubs. Plus, you will meet new friends from other area high schools.

What are the requirements?

Starlight Junior Board members must complete an application and be accepted to the board. We accept those who are sophomores, juniors, seniors, or recent graduates. Occasionally, exceptions will be made for younger members. Members need to attend meeting and concerts. Typically, concert nights require three-four hours of time. Junior Board members are asked to wear a plain white or blue shirt (either polo-type or nice t-shirt) and khakis, capri pants or shorts (of modest length). Shoe preference is a tennis shoe or sturdy sandal.

Concerts:

Our regular concerts are on Tuesdays nights at 8pm. They are held at Guthrie Green, 111 E. Brady in Tulsa. This year we have 8 concerts! Six at Guthrie Green and two additional concerts: Broken Arrow's Tuesday in the Park (7 PM), and Utica Square's Fifth Night (7 PM). All dates and locations are on our website.

Our Junior Board arrives at 6 PM to help set up and typically leaves around 10 PM, after we put things away.
